

What does the council do?

Support	Makes recommendations regarding how to classify invasives species and procedures for awarding grants to control invasives.
Research	Conducts studies of issues related to controlling invasive species.
Oversight	Addresses how organisms in trade (bait industry, pet sales, online sales) affect the introduction and spread of invasives species.

Who makes up the council?

- Volunteers that come from a variety of backgrounds:
 - Industry representatives
 - Wisconsin Agri-Business Association
 - University staff
 - State agencies
 - Tribal nations
 - Members of the public















Criteria for Regulation

- The following criteria are considered when determining which species qualify for regulation under NR40:
 - The potential for the species to cause harm economically, environmentally, or to human health.
 - The extent to which the species is already present in the state.
 - The likelihood that the species will become established and spread within the state.
 - The potential for eradicating the species or controlling the species' spread within the state.
 - The socio-economic value of a species, including any beneficial uses or values the species may provide for recreation, commerce, agriculture or industry within the state.

General Overview of NR40

• Classifies invasive species in Wisconsin as Prohibited or Restricted and regulates the transportation, possession, transfer, and introduction of those species.

Prohibited	Restricted	Split-listed

What are they?


A collection of stakeholders and experts that have valuable input for the species being reviewed.
