0:00	Purpose of the lesson: The purpose of the lesson is to show students the affects alcohol/drugs will have on a person. Then, relate what they have learned to the operation of an ATV/snowmobile.	
5:00	<u>E-EDUCATE</u> The law: No person can operate an ATV/snowmobile while under the influence of an intoxicant to a degree, which renders him or her incapable of safe ATV/snowmobile operation. And above all, no person is allowed to operate an ATV/snowmobile while the person has an alcohol	May mean only 1 beer or drink

<p>20:00</p>	<p>concentration of 0.08 or more.</p> <p>Causing Injury:</p> <p>You can cause injury or death to a person if you're intoxicated. If this happens, the penalties are much more severe, such as high fines and possibly going to prison. It is important to know:</p> <p>Alcohol and drugs slow your reflexes, affects how you see, your sense of balance, your judgement, and gives you a feeling of being warm when you are not.</p> <p><u>OWI Drunk Buster Goggle Use:</u></p> <p>Maintain adult supervision at all times. Instructors shall closely monitor the students to steady them in case they become unbalanced. If students begin to engage in horseplay, discontinue the activity.</p> <p><u>D-DEMONSTRATE</u></p> <p>While sitting on the ATV/snowmobile an instructor will remove an ignition key from his/her pocket and place into ignition and simulate starting the ATV/Snowmobile.</p> <p>Repeat procedure utilizing Drunk Buster goggles.</p> <p><u>O-OBSERVE</u></p> <p>Ask for 2 or 3 student volunteers and repeat above procedure.</p> <p><u>C-CONGRATULATE</u></p> <p>Congratulate students for participating in activity.</p>	<p>Reinforce no alcohol is best</p> <p>ATV/snow mobile</p> <p>Drunk Buster Goggles</p>
