The Natural Resources Foundation of Wisconsin has donated \$45,000. This donation will be used for protection of pollinator habitat at Rush Creek State Natural Area.





SUMMARY:

This donation comes from NRF’s Pollinator Protection Fund. It will be used at Rush Creek State Natural Area, which is a two-mile long dry alkaline prairie situated along the steep bluffs of the Mississippi River in Crawford County. This is one of the largest dry prairie remnants remaining in the state. Work at this site will include removal of invasive species, planting and seeding adapted to changing climate conditions. NRF has communicated their preference not to receive a certificate of acknowledgement for this donation.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board acknowledge the generous donation of \$45,000 from the Natural Resources Foundation of Wisconsin.
