Donation of a bike trail valued at \$156,000 in Lake Kegonsa State Park in Dane County, WI.

## **SUMMARY:**

Dane County will be donating a bike trail valued at \$156,000 dollars as a segment of the Lower Yahara River Trail in Lake Kegonsa State Park. The North Mendota Trail is identified in Dane County's Parks and Open Space Plan as a trail connection from the Capital City State Trail at Lake Farm County Park to Stoughton. Phase 1 of the Lower Yahara River Trail. Phase 1 of the Lower Yahara River Trail was completed in 2017 from the Capital City Trail to McDaniel Park in the Village of McFarland that included a nearly 1-mile long bridge and boardwalk along the north shore of Lake Waubesa. The trail segment at Lake Kegonsa State Park is part of Phase 2 of the trail that will connect Lake Kegonsa State Park to Fish Camp County Park, located just south of the Village of McFarland.

The total distance of the donated trail at Lake Kegonsa State Park will be approximately 1,300 feet and will be constructed, operated, and maintained by Dane County. This project is anticipated to begin in Fall/Winter 2022 with completion by late 2023 or early 2024.

A land use agreement for construction, operations, and maintenance of the trail with Dane County will be associated with this project.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Natural Resources Board accepts this donation valued at \$156,000 dollars from Dane County.
