

	<p>2. Ventilated</p> <p>3. Tinted-Explain different shades for different weather/lighting conditions.</p> <p><u>Gloves:</u></p> <p>A good pair of gloves is essential for riding comfort. Off-road style gloves offer the best protection.</p> <p>Offer protection from rocks, branches, or other debris, cold weather and handlebar fatigue.</p> <p><u>Boots:</u></p> <p>As a minimum, over the ankle hiking style boots should be worn. The best protection is provided by off-road style ATV/motorcycle boots.</p> <p><u>Outer Clothing:</u></p> <p>Long sleeved shirt and pants offer minimal protection.
