SUMMARY:

Three main objectives are:

- 1. Provide a snapshot overview of the APM permitting program and its performance for the past season so the Board understands the depth and breadth of the program.
- 2. Revisit and update the Board on the status of Eurasian watermilfoil management and aquatic invasive species in general as a follow up to a presentation made in February 2017 at Dr. Prehn's request. At that time, our forthcoming proposal for rule development was mentioned and the program was encouraged to come back with an update.
- 3. Introduce the topic of integrated pest management (IPM), which is a key concept of the proposed rule that will be presented to the Board for adoption in June 2022. IPM currently is utilized in other department invasive species management and this presentation will briefly explain its extension to APM.
