Spring Turkey Hunting Questionnaire **2021**

Abstract

Spring turkey hunting was an ideal way for many to be outside and be socially distant during the continuing coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Seventy-three percent (72.9%) of all spring turkey hunters that received at least one harvest permit hunted turkeys during the 2021 spring turkey season and the overall success rate for active hunters was 33.5%. On a scale of 1 to 10, with 10 being the best and 1 being the worst, hunters rated their overall satisfaction with spring turkey hunting in Wisconsin as a '6.6'.

Methods




Figure 1. Continued.

A sample of hunter names and addresses were randomly drawn from the current spring turkey hunter permit file. A survey was mailed to 10,000 spring turkey hunters after the completion of the spring turkey season. The questionnaire was mailed in proportion to the number of permits distributed in each zone. The questionnaire asked each hunter specific questions about their spring turkey hunting experience (Figure 1). A second mailing was sent to all non-respondents. Data from all returned questionnaires were summarized using the Statistical Analysis System (SAS).

Results

A total of 3,751 spring turkey hunter surveys were returned. After duplicates were removed, the resulting response rate was 37.4%. Statewide, 7.0% of survey respondents participated in the youth turkey hunt as a youth or chaperone; of those, 17.9% reported a turkey being harvested (Table 1, Question 1).

Statewide, 72.9% of the respondents hunted turkeys this spring, down from 79.5% in 2020. Of those who did not hunt, 54.9% bought a 2021 wild turkey stamp (Table 1, Question 2). The success rate for active hunters who received a harvest permit was 33.5% (Table 1, Question 9). This success rate may be high because of response and prestige biases of a mail survey. The spring turkey harvest registration data success rate (16.9%) is uncorrected for nonhunters and is probably a low estimate.

Many spring turkey hunters stay close to home to hunt, only traveling on average 60 miles from their residence to their hunting location (Table 1, Question 3). Thirty-nine (38.6%) percent of hunters stayed overnight at their hunting location (Table 1, Question 4).

Surveyed hunters were asked how difficult it was to find a place to hunt in the spring of 2021, and 77.8% of the respondents said it was 'Very Easy' or 'Somewhat Easy' (Table 1, Question 5). Spring turkey hunters were also asked to report the days on which they hunted. Hunting pressure was relatively constant Wednesday through Sunday, with the most pressure on Saturday. Monday and Tuesday had the least hunting pressure (Table 1, Question 6). Hunters averaged 3.8 days a field pursuing turkeys.

Statewide, the mean "# of Gobblers/Jakes seen" by hunters was 3.3; the "mean # of Gobblers/Jakes heard" by hunters was 4.0; the mean "# of Hens seen" was 5.2, and the mean "# of Hens heard" was 2.8 (Table 1, Question 7). Fifty-four percent (54.1%) of respondents did not shoot at the first legal turkey they had in range of the weapon they were using; 84.1% reported waiting for a better shot, or for an adult gobbler (Table 1, Question 8).

Of the respondents that harvested a turkey, 25.7% with one tag harvested one turkey; 29.7% with two tags harvested one turkey, and 10.4% harvested two turkeys; 28.3% with three or more tags harvested one turkey, 16.3% harvested two turkeys, and 10.2% harvested three or more turkeys (Table 1, Question 9a). Surveyed hunters were asked if they hit any turkeys that they were unable to retrieve; 4.3% were unable to find their bird, 66 hunters reported hitting one turkey, and 4 hunters reported hitting 2 turkeys (Table 1, Question 10). Ninety-five percent (94.9%) of turkey hunters used a gun 'most' while hunting, while a gun was used 96.7% of the time to kill a turkey (Table 1, Question 11 and 9b).

The percent of time turkey hunters spent on private land varied by TMZ from 63.3% in TMZ 7 to 87.9% in TMZ 1 (Table 1, Question 12). Of the hunters on private land, 36.0% owned the land and 58.0% hunted land owned by a friend or relative (Table 1, Question 13). Only 4.6% of hunters on private land hunted land open via the Turkey Hunter Access Program (THAP) (Table 1, Question 13a). Seventy-seven percent (77.3%) of those that hunted land open to public access saw turkeys and 14.3% harvested a turkey (Table 1, Question 13b).

Fourteen percent (13.8%) of hunters responded to 'Other hunters kept me from hunting where I wanted to' with 'Definitely Yes', or 'Somewhat'. Twelve percent (12.2%) of respondents answered, 'There was too much competition from other hunters where I hunted' with 'Definitely Yes', or 'Somewhat'. Only 9.6% of the respondents indicated that other hunters interfered with their chance to bag a bird (Table 1, Question 14).

Thirty-three percent (32.5%) of respondents rated the quality of their spring turkey hunting as 'Very High' or 'Fairly High', similarly 34.5% rated their hunt as 'Fairly Low' or 'Very Low' (Table 1, Question 15). The most important factor that influenced respondents' perceptions of a quality hunt was 'seeing turkeys/calling birds in/hearing gobbling'. The least important factors were 'Weather' and 'Not seeing other hunters' (Table 1, Question 16).

Only eight percent (7.8%) of respondents felt that turkey numbers in the zones they hunted in the spring increased relative to the year before (Table 1, Question 17). Most hunters (73.0%) would like to see the number of permits available for the zone(s) they hunted stay the same as opposed to increase or decrease (Table 1, Question 18).

On a scale of 1 to 10, with 10 being the best and 1 being the worst, hunters rated their overall satisfaction with spring turkey hunting in Wisconsin as a '6.6' (Table 1, Question 19).
