0:00	E- Educate: Background It is important that you learn the safe start-up procedure when you begin your ride. BONEC should become an automatic routine every ride you take. D-Demonstrate: Instructor will demonstrate the BONEC Start-Up Procedure (while sitting on the ATV) using the BONEC form for a teaching visual aid. B- Brake Set parking brake. O- On	BONE C Handout
	Turn Gas valve to ON Position.	

Turn Ignition to ON Position.

N- Neutral

Check that the Transmission is in Neutral.

- 1. Neutral indicator light (or)
- 2. Release parking brake and roll ATV forward or back. Reset the parking brake if this procedure is used.

E- Engine

Check that the engine stop switch is in the Run/Start position.

C- Choke

Use choke if needed.

***When demonstrating, always mount your ATV from the left side. Always look around for safety hazards. Always keep both hands on the handlebars and both feet on the footrests; use proper posture. Tell students when starting off to gradually increase pressure on throttle. Gradually apply pressure on brakes to slow machine down. Use engine stop switch to shut machine off. Turn ignition key off. Dismount from left side.

O-Observe

Select a few students and have them conduct the BONEC Start-Up Procedure utilizing BONEC Form A and BONEC Form B. Last student selected would not use any form.

C-Congratulate

Congratulate the students who participated in the handson activity. BONE C (Form A and B)
