

Eagle Tower

Peninsula State Park's Eagle Tower features an 850 foot accessible ramp that winds through a tree canopy to a scenic view of Green Bay from the top of the tower.

In 2023, outdoor wheelchairs are coming to Wisconsin State Parks. All-terrain wheelchairs are arriving at Peninsula State Park and Point Beach State Forest. A manually powered GRIT wheelchair is coming to Kettle Moraine State Forest - Pike Lake Unit. We are working to add more, so stay tuned!
