History has shown that fatal incidents have involved breaking one or more of these seven safety rules.</p> <p>By violating even one of the following seven safety rules you increase the chance of <u>property damage</u>, <u>personal injury</u> or <u>death</u> occurring.</p> <p>These are the seven safety rules. Have students write them down on the form provided.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Always wear a helmet. 2. Avoid excessive speed. 3. No drugs or alcohol. 4.
