	<u>D-Demonstrate</u>	
	Instructor will point out to the students the location and function of all the controls and common parts on the ATV:	
	Brakes-front, rear, foot and hand	

	Clutch-on manual shift models	
	Choke-discuss different styles, possible locations and symbol	
	Drive Systems-chain, drive shaft, 2-wheel, 4-wheel (AWD)	
	Engine-different sizes, air, water, oil cooling methods	
	Engine stop switch	
	Footrests-different styles, protection offered	
	Fuel shut -off valve-hand operated or automatic, possibly 3 positions	
	Gear Selector-automatic, semi-auto, electric, manual	
	Ignition Switch-how it works	
	<u>Light Switch</u> -function, high/low beam	
	Parking Brake-discuss different latching arrangements	
	Start Switch/Pull Start-	
10:00	Spark Arrester Muffler-function of muffler and spark arrester	
	Throttle Lever-discuss location and how it controls engine speed
