#### **Northern Highland American Legion State Forest offers**

two group campgrounds with space for up to 80 campers at each location. These campgrounds are located at Jag Lake and Big Muskellunge Lake. Group campgrounds provide a unique camping opportunity for large groups such as large family gatherings, Boy and Girl Scouts and church groups — but are not limited to these. These solitary areas allow campers to have a rustic camping experience while not affecting other campers. These sites may be occupied up to seven nights per visit, and only seven nights within any 14-day period.

Camping reservations are required and can be made for the same day of your arrival or up to 11 months in advance of your planned date of occupancy. Campers must make a reservation before setting up on the site.

#### **CAMPGROUND RULES**

- Campers must make a reservation before setting up on the site.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time: Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- Noise may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- Generators may be used from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
